

subscriptions

methods of payment

NACO subscriptions can be paid for by direct debit or by deduction from salary by your employer (check-off).

direct debit

If you wish to pay your subscriptions by direct debit, please complete the mandate on the membership application form and return it to NACO registered office.

check-off

The majority of societies operate a facility for subscriptions to be deducted direct from salary on a proportional basis throughout the year. If you wish to take advantage of this facility, please follow the procedure below:

1. Check that your employing society provides this facility.
2. Complete the authorisation on the reverse of the membership application form and return it to NACO registered office.
3. Do not send cash payments.

Full Membership

Full membership will be split into two subscription categories, one where the member works in excess of 25 hours per week, the second where the member of staff works 25 hours per week or less.

Unity Membership

A full membership category for individuals whose gross annual salary is £25,000 or less. A copy of your CURRENT payslip must accompany the application.

Individual Representation Only

Membership shall be open to persons deemed qualified who work within the Co-operative Movement in the United Kingdom.

Affiliate Membership

Affiliate Membership shall be open to persons who work within the Co-operative Movement world-wide, also those who have an interest in furthering Co-operative ideals and principles through education, research or mutual interest groups.

Contract Membership

Contract Membership shall be open to persons employed within the Co-operative Movement under long-term contracts (with a minimum 6 months to run at the date of the application).

Any clarification of these categories should be sought from the NACO Head Office.
